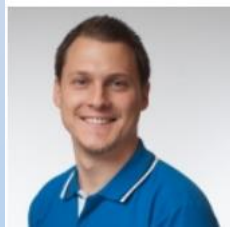

# The school day



## **ALL CHILDREN START ON A PART-TIME TIMETABLE**

Once settled and full-time, these are the timings of the school day:

- School gates open at 8.30
- Children come into class at 8.40 and gates close
- School gates open at 3.00
- The class teacher will open the class doors and school finishes at 3.15 pm

- Lunch

Lunch time is 11:30 – 12:30

A hot school lunch is £10.50 per week  
or you could bring a healthy packed lunch to  
school for your child

- Illness

If your child has sickness/ diarrhoea they  
must stay off school for **48hours after**  
**the sickness has stopped** to ensure  
the illness doesn't spread

# Uniform

• All children are expected to wear full St Philip's uniform every day:

-Black or grey shorts, trousers, skirt or pinafore dress

-White polo shirts

# Uniform

- No nail varnish/ makeup
  
- Children will need to have a Physical Education kit so they can fully take part in lessons. **No logos/ patterns/ pictures please**
- Plain white T-shirt
- Black/ dark grey shorts/ sport trousers
- Dark pumps/ sports shoes

- Parents/Carers can also upload photos, videos and text to share children's interests at home too!
