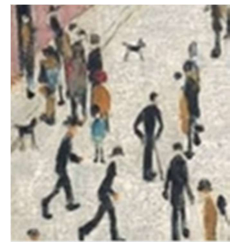


Going to the match- LS LOWRY



- D- Explain why you think the painting was given this title?
- I- What sort of people might be going to watch the match?

- L- What different colours can you see LS Lowry has used in this painting?

Writing - One of the differences in Lowry's paintings is the way he painted and drew people and animals. They have very simple faces; you can't even see their expressions and their clothes are very simple.



Task 1: Using lines or real matchsticks make one character in the style of a Lowry picture

Task 2: Imagine your character is from one of the paintings. Around the picture write things about your character. Think about your characters: name, job, age, their family, where they live, whether they are happy or not.

Task 3: Using full sentences describe the character and their life. Use different types of sentences, conjunctions and adjectives.
