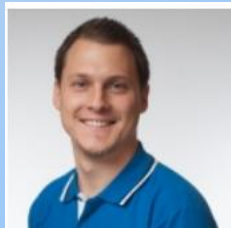

The school day



ALL CHILDREN START ON A PART-TIME TIMETABLE

Once settled and full-time, these are the timings of the school day:

- School gates open at 8.30 on the main playground
- Children line up and come into class at 8.40
Gates close at 8.45 on the second bell
- School finishes at 3.15 pm
- The class teacher will open the class doors and dismiss the children from the Early Years gate

Lunch

Lunch time is 11:30 – 12:30

A hot school lunch is £10.50 per week

or you could bring a healthy packed lunch to school for your child



Please let us know about any dietary requirements / allergies

We are a nut-free school, please do not pack any food with nuts in (including Nutella)

If your child has packed lunch, please make it a healthy one – no chocolate, sweets, fizzy drinks are allowed

Bagels are provided in the morning for the whole family – please come and join us on the playground from 8.30

Additional funding is provided to school for pupils who receive free school meals so please check!

School meals must be ordered online by **Sunday evening for the following week**. If this is not done, your child will be given a cheese sandwich and fruit.

Illness and absence

If your child has sickness/ diarrhoea they must stay off school for **48hours after the illness has stopped** to ensure the illness doesn't spread

Uniform

- All children are expected to wear full St Philip's uniform every day:

- Black or grey shorts, trousers, skirt or pinafore dress
- White polo shirt/ shirt
- Navy blue jumper/ cardigan
- Summer dress (Optional)
- Black school shoes (No coloured logos/ white soles/ pattern) **NO LACES PLEASE**
- Stud earrings (removed/ covered for PE)



Uniform

- Children will also need to bring a pair of wellington boots to leave at school for outdoor play
- Please ensure children bring a warm, outdoor coat to school each day
- No nail varnish/ makeup
- Children will need to have a Physical Education kit so they can fully take part in lessons. You will be informed of your child's PE days – they must wear their kit to school on these days.
- **No logos/ patterns/ pictures please**
 - Plain white T-shirt
 - Black/ dark grey shorts/ sport trousers
 - Dark pumps/ sports shoes



Uniform

- **Please bring a spare set of underwear, socks and trousers/skirt to leave in your child's tray – accidents happen!**

How will I know how my child is doing?

- **Tapestry**- An App for your phone/ tablet/ accessible on the computer.
- This is a way staff and home can share children's learning.
- Staff will upload observations which are accessible with your own unique password so you can see what your children have been learning at school.
- Parents/Carers can also upload photos, videos and text to share children's interests at home too!
