Mrs Paisley played a huge part in the life of our school and has been extremely supportive over many years. She had been involved with school as a parent and grandparent, playgroup leader for Little Pips, Breakfast Club leader, lunchtime organiser and a TA across the school, providing support for lots of children, their families and staff. We will miss her deeply here at St Philip's.

We will be sharing this news with the children on Tuesday morning at 9:00am as part of a special reflection time. On Friday, as part of our Remembrance Worship, we will be holding a minute's reflection time and saying a prayer for her and her family. We invite you to come and join us for this as we will also be marking Remembrance Day with poppies and prayers.

We appreciate that this is a sensitive issue and you may want to discuss this with your child beforehand. Please come and speak to myself, Mrs Brandreth, Mr Steadman or your child's classteacher separately if you wish to discuss this further.

In memory of Mrs Paisley, we will be collecting for St Ann's Hospice, who took such good care of her and her family while she was ill. Staff have donated prizes for a charity raffle.
