Home reading books

These books are used to support Speaking and Listening skills which are very important in the journey of learning how to read.

-Please encourage your child to hold the book and turn the pages themselves - showing them to turn the pages one at a time if needed.

-Encourage your child to use the pictures to tell the story/ talk about what is happening in the pictures. If your child needs a little support, you can tell the story for your child and talk about the pictures with them. (This can be done in your home language if more appropriate.)

-Ask your child about what is happening in the book: What can they see? How does the character feel? How many X can they see? What might happen on the next page? Would they like to ride in a train like the character? E.G.

Your child's book will be changed when they have read it 2 times with an adult at home. Please write this in their reading record so we know you have read. A member of Nursery staff will check reading records regularly.

Your child may get the same book more than once; this allows them to explore a book in a different way as they may have learnt new vocabulary or developed new story-telling skills.
