Dear Parents/Carers,

Bridgewater Bubble

Due to there being a high number of cases in Year 6 and the level of contact your child may have had, **this class will now be a bubble** which will end on Friday 26th November (unless otherwise stated).

This now means that the following will be implemented:

MORNING ROUTINE:

8:45am onwards – your child will be met at the car park gates and walked through the car park by a member of staff from the bubble.

8:50am – your child will be taken to class through the Peace Garden and will not walk through school.

DURING THE DAY:

- Your child will now have breaktimes at a different time to the rest of school.
- Lunchtimes will be in their classroom and playtimes will be separate in specific zones away from other children.

END OF THE DAY:

3:00pm – your child will leave the classroom through the Peace Garden and be brought to you at the car park gates by a member of staff

OTHER INFORMATION:

- Your child will not integrate into lessons whilst in the bubble or attend small group activities beyond their bubble.
- Your child will attend assemblies and whole school worship online and not in the hall.
- Specific staff will be with your child throughout this time and will not mix with other staff.
- Windows will be kept open and the children will have access to their own toilets. Staff will wear face coverings as required. There will not be any visitors in the classroom. Parents Evening will be remote as already stated.
- The children will still be able to come in non-uniform on Friday 19th and they will still be doing PE but this will be outside. Please make sure that they come ready for the weather!

Please continue to monitor your child's symptoms and get a PCR test in the event of them showing signs. We would encourage you to use LFTs with your child at least every other day and **preferably daily** whilst they are in the bubble. If in doubt, please contact us here at school and if they are poorly, you must keep your child at home and contact school.
