Morning Session:

7.30 – 8.45am with drop off

Cost = £5 per session

Afternoon Session:

3.00 – 6.00pm with pick up from school

Cost = £5 per hour



Please Note – There must be a minimum of 10 children on each session for the session to run otherwise the session will be cancelled.

What's included?

The morning session will include a breakfast of cereal, toast and bagels along with activities.

The afternoon session includes juice and snacks with different activities daily.



If you are a working parent and you claim Universal Credit or Working Tax Credits then you could be entitled to claim up to 80% back of the cost of childcare. Further information can be found at www.childcarechoices.gov.uk

TAX-FREE CHILDCARE

Age **0-11**
or 16 if disabled

GET UP TO **£2000** PER CHILD

- For **working families**, including the self-employed, **in the UK**
- Earning **under £100k** and **at least £139** per week (equal to 16 hours at the National Minimum or Living Wage) each
- Who **aren't** receiving Tax Credits, Universal Credit or childcare vouchers
- With children aged 0-11 (or 0-16 if disabled)
- For every £8 you pay into an online account, the government will add an extra £2, **up to £2,000 per child per year**
- If your working pattern and/or income has changed because of coronavirus (COVID-19); before you apply or reconfirm, please read [how the changes may affect your eligibility](#).

You can receive **up to £2,000 per child per year** - that's up to £500 every three months. If you have a disabled child, you can receive up to £4,000 per child - that's up to £1,000 every three months.

Childcare Choices

Am I eligible?

You, and any partner, must be over 16 and each expect to earn (on average) at least £139 per week (equal to 16 hours at the National Minimum or Living Wage).

If you, or your partner, are on maternity, paternity or adoption leave, or you're unable to work because you are disabled or have caring responsibilities, you could still be eligible.

You **can't** get Tax-Free Childcare if either you, or your partner, each individually expect to earn £100,000 or more.

UNIVERSAL CREDIT FOR CHILDCARE

Age **0-16**

- For working families claiming Universal Credit, **in England, Scotland, Northern Ireland and Wales**
- With **children under 17***
- Up to 85% of eligible childcare costs
- Who **aren't** receiving Tax-Free Childcare

Is it for me? ^

Am I eligible?

You, and any partner, must be working, or you're due to start work, and are claiming Universal Credit.

Whether you can claim will depend on your personal circumstances.

How can I benefit?

You can claim back up to 85% of your eligible childcare costs for children under 17. You could get up to £646 a month for one child, or £1,108 for two or more.
