Dear Parent/Carers,

I am writing to inform you that school will **continue to be open** until we receive alternative information from the Local Authority or the Government.

In light of this, I want to keep you updated of all the actions that we are taking in order to support you and your child during this time of uncertainty and worry:

- We continue to ensure the children are washing their hands frequently throughout the day and using a range of resources and songs to remind them of the correct way.
- We continue to sterilise all water bottles every night.
- We are ensuring that all handles and doors are wiped down regularly along with tables, chairs, work tops and classroom sinks.
- We ensure that tables in the dinner hall are spread out to allow more distance between the children.
- We continue to contact parents/carers to provide updates on the current situation.
- We advise all parents/carers of the latest government guidance when a child is showing symptoms: **self-isolate the household for 14 days.**  
**If your child is experiencing other illness without the high temperature or coughing, we ask that you keep them at home until they are fully recovered.**

We have a very dedicated team of staff who have been in school everyday to ensure that your children receive the best possible support and care. They are working tirelessly to ensure that the children continue their learning journey throughout this time.

As a result, you will be receiving the following over the next few days:

- A pack of work specific to your child that you can use in the event of self-isolation or school closure. (This is being sent out now in preparation for any changes; it is not a sign that we are closing yet).
- For children in Key Stage 2, you will receive a log-in for Google Classroom. Your children can access work set by the classteacher using their log in and can send it through to their teacher online during prolonged periods of absence and/or in the event of school closure.
