### Opening and Closing

The school gates open **at 8:40am every morning and are locked at 9:00am.**

Gates open to collect after school at **2:55pm and are locked at 3:10am.**

This will be indicated by the school bell.

You will need to go to the correct gate.

Only **one adult** will be allowed on site and **you must wear a face covering.**

### Uniform

Please make sure that you send the children in the correct uniform. Details of the uniform can be found on the school website. You do not need a logo on jumpers or cardigans but they are available through our supplier (details on the website). Remember - **All black shoes or trainers.**

### PE lessons
