Main restrictions from Thursday 5 November



Pubs and restaurants closed but takeaways permitted



Non-essential shops, leisure and entertainment venues closed



No households mixing indoors, or in private gardens, unless in your support bubble



Stay home – only leave for specific reasons including education and work



Schools, universities and colleges remain open



Outdoor recreation encouraged, you can meet one person outside your household

You must follow the Government guidance for the next 4 weeks.

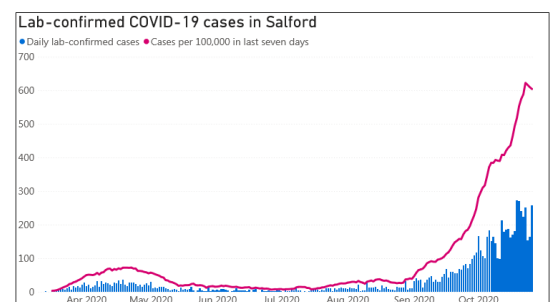
What we as a school are asking you to do...

- You must not mix outside of your household.
- Make sure that, if your child walks home by themselves, they go straight home and do not mix with others.
- Your child does not attend parties, bonfires, sleepovers etc with others at other people's houses
- Keep school informed if you or any of your house have symptoms or are waiting for a test result.
