Dear Parents/Carers,

Thank you so much for the support you have shown to us to open as safely as possible. We are grateful for the way you have followed our guidelines and routines. This is much appreciated.

We would just like to update you on a few things to help you organise your weeks and to help us maintain the safety of our school.

Dinner Money

If you are paying for school dinners, please put the dinner money in a sealed envelope with your child's name, class and the amount enclosed. Your child must hand it to the teacher who will send it to the office.

Snacks and Fruit

We request that you do not send your child with fruit or snacks to limit what is being brought onto the school site. We provide free fruit to KS1 and Early Years. Bagels are delivered to every classroom at the start of the day.

We also politely request that **no cakes or sweets are brought into school for birthdays**. Again, this is to limit the risk of transmission.

Bags

The children do not need to bring bags into school at this time. They have been provided with everything that they need in their classroom trays. If your child brings a packed lunch they may bring it in a lunchbox but no other bags are needed.

Uniform

Please make sure your child is wearing the correct uniform each day. Please make sure that **school shoes are all black.**

PE Kits

We ask that you send your child in their PE kit on their PE day instead of their school uniform. In light of the changing weather, PE kits need to be warm and suitable for the weather conditions as your child will be in this all day. We suggest:

- Black tracksuit
- White T-Shirt
- Trainers (pumps can be worn but these will not be as practical as trainers)
