### In response:

- We reintroduced the playground zones to reinstate ball specific areas.
- We increased the number of staff available at lunchtime to maximise the use of the gym equipment and play space and reduce the number of children on the playground.
- Sparkle group has taken on the responsibility for encouraging children to sign up to play on the additional zones before school.
- Sparkle group delivered an assembly to clarify the activities that can be played on the different zones. They designed and produced posters for the playground to remind children of the games they can play in each area.
