Children of key workers should only be sent to school if BOTH PARENTS are key workers and not working from home. You may be asked to provide proof of this. There will be no after school clubs until further notice.

If your child has an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP), please contact school so that arrangements can be made for your child.

If you feel that your child requires a place and did not have one previously, please contact school from 7:00am tomorrow morning to discuss this with myself, Ms Jackson or Mrs Lewis.

For all other pupils, online learning will begin on Wednesday. In addition, workpacks will also be available from Wednesday onwards. We will contact you about these packs tomorrow.

Additional information will be sent out to you this week regarding live lessons, free school meals and any updates we have received from the Government or the Local Authority.

We are currently struggling to send out text messages but will continue to send information as best we can. Please keep checking the school website for up-to-date information.
